ABUSE OF POWER

MAHB senior GM remanded

PUTRAJAYA: A Malaysia Airports Holdings Bhd (MAHB) senior general manager, who allegedly abused his position to obtain RM80,000 worth of skin and slimming treatment for himself, was remanded for four days by the magistrate's court yesterday.

The remand order, issued by magistrate Nik Isfahanie Tasnim Wan Ab against the 41-year-old suspect, was to assist the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) in its investigation. He is being investigated under Section 23 of the MACC Act 2009.

The senior general manager at the human resources department was arrested at his home in Bandar Tun Razak, Cheras, at 11am

on Wednesday.

MACC said investigations said the suspect was found to have allegedly abused his position to approve the amount to receive treatment from a private clinic and hospital in the Klang Valley between December 2015 and August last year.

It was learnt the suspect, who was believed to have suffered from obesity, allegedly misused the corporate credit card provided by MAHB to undergo a surgery which was not stipulated in the contract.

The suspect was appointed as the division's general manager in January 2015 and was promoted to senior manager in December.
