## **MACC FILES POLICE REPORT AGAINST MOHD SAIFULLAH**

THE Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) would like to emphasise that the police report filed by the former Senior Private Secretary to the Minister of Tourism, Arts and Culture, Mohd Saifullah Mohd Minggu @ Mohd Hisham, against MACC is false, irresponsible and an intent to tarnish MACC's reputation and credibility.

Mohd Saifullah is a suspect in a corruption investigation and was charged at the Kuala Lumpur Sessions Court on 19 August 2020 with 17 charges under Section 16(a)(B) MACC Act 2009 and one charge with his fiancée, Nurfadziana Abdul Kadir under Section 28(1)(c) MACC Act 2009.

MACC has filed a report at the Putrajaya District Police Headquarters today in order for the police to conduct an investigation for the offence of making a false report.
