PRESS STATEMENT MALAYSIAN ANTI- CORRUPTION COMMISSION

MACC INVESTIGATES ALLEGATIONS OF CORRUPTION INVOLVING NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL OIL AND GAS COMPANY PROJECTS

Regarding allegations of corruption involving PETRONAS projects and an international oil and gas company that was posted on a portal recently, the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) confirmed that it has opened an investigation paper into the issue.

PETRONAS has provided full cooperation to the MACC in the investigation involving the project worth RM399 million in Sarawak.

So far, MACC has found several weaknesses in practices, systems and work procedures regarding the issue. Accordingly, the Commission has proposed improvements to the standard operating procedures (SOP) as preventive measures.

MACC has also called upon any party with new information regarding this issue to come forward and channel it to the Commission for further investigation under the MACC Act 2009.

SPRM turut disokong oleh mekanisme *check and balance* dalam memastikan SPRM bertindak selaras dengan kehendak perundangan negara dan aspirasi masyarakat. Suruhanjaya ini dahulunya dikenali sebagai Badan Pencegah Rasuah (BPR).
